### CAMP PROGRAM

ITKF has finally established an epochal, new Traditional Karate system showing evidence of both Budo martial arts and sports science.

This year, ITKF has created a unique program that, in one total package, incorporates the new Traditional Karate training system and competition, based on Budo philosophy and fundamentals.

1. General Course  
Traditional Karate principles applied to techniques in general using the new system.
2. Masters' Course
  - a. Applied Traditional Karate principles as educational art and Budo in training, instruction and completion.
  - b. Coaches' Certification Course and Judges' Registration Course with examinations for both.  
*Note: One year "Instructor License" will be issued to technical officials upon completion of Masters' Course.*
3. Medical Clinic for Medical Officials (Separate Registration Required).

### INSTRUCTORS

This year's camp will again be conducted and directed by **Master Hidetaka Nishiyama** and ITKF Technical Committee members.

## APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION

### -APPLICATION-

1. All camp participants must process official Application Form and all fees through their respective AAKF club or ITKF National Federation which must then submit them directly to the ITKF National Office (1930 Wilshire Blvd., Suite 1007, Los Angeles, California 90057, U.S.A.). Checks should be made payable to "International Traditional Karate Federation" and received by May 31, 2008. After this date, applications will still be accepted; however, your choice of dorm room cannot be guaranteed.

2. Personal checks will be accepted prior to May 31, 2008. All payments made after that date must be in cash or cashier's check, personal checks will not be accepted.
3. Camp participants who plan to arrive early (before July 11, 2008) or leave after Camp ends (July 18, 2008) please be sure to indicate on your Camp application form if you wish to reserve a dorm room at the Camp site.
4. Camp participants with no U.S. medical insurance must purchase Travelers Insurance for the entire duration of Camp.

## SAN DIEGO AREA RECREATION

San Diego boasts the "shortness" of its thermometer, which never moves very far toward either extreme heat or extreme cold. The average July temperature hovers around 70 degrees, leading some people to proclaim the area "one of the most favored spots on earth."

La Jolla, a fashionable beach suburb of San Diego, is also the site of the Scripps Institute of Oceanography, Aquarium & Museum. Close-by are a host of recreational and cultural attractions including Sea World, the San Diego Zoo, fishing, surfing and water skiing at Mission Bay, and the wonderful landscaping, architecture, art galleries, theatres and museums of Balboa Park.

Participants are welcome to bring their families to the Camp. The housing units are apartment style with complete kitchen areas. Towels and sheets are provided by the university. A coin-operated Laundromat is conveniently located within the Muir Campus.

## TRANSPORTATION
